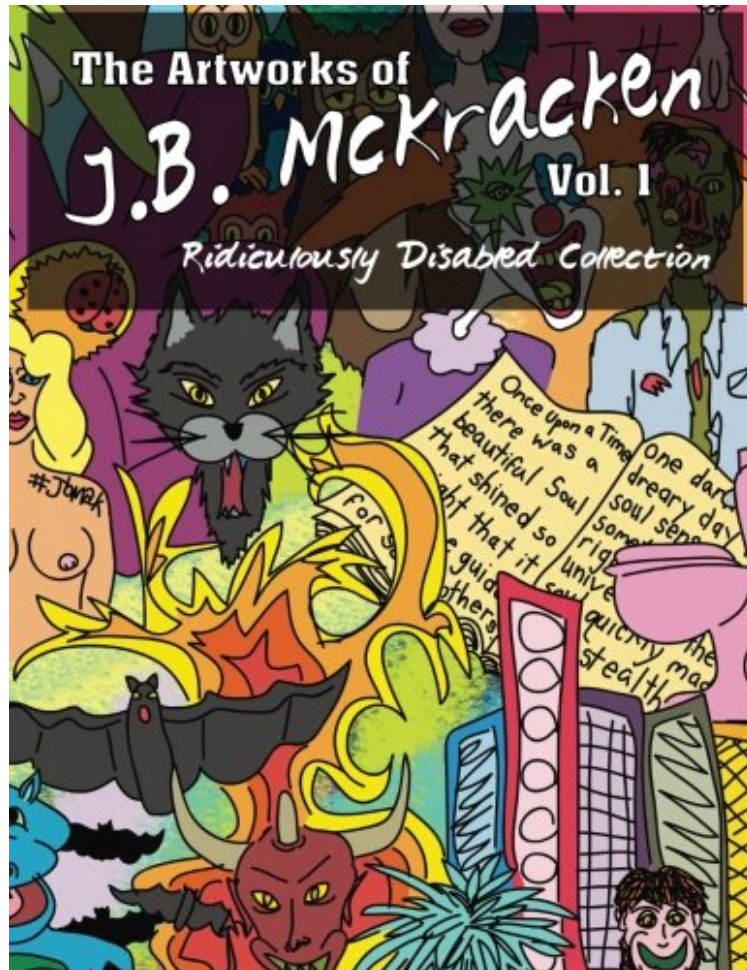

Within his first two years it was discovered that JB had a genetic neuromuscular disease that was going to hinder his independence for life. However, because of enthusiastic support of his family and a positive attitude towards life, JB has been able to live a productive life. From the beginning, JB always had an interest in visual arts. Spending hours at a time drawing and painting at his home, JB developed an appreciation for self-expression at a young age. However, throughout his early years he noticed changes in his strength and it became more difficult for JB to use traditional methods to develop his art. This is when he began to experiment and seek out new methods of expression. In 2002, JB began testing the use of digital graphic design methods. He desperately wanted a way to use the computer to portray his art by utilizing different brush styles and layering to give the appearance of hand-painted art. Magically, he was able to achieve such a goal. He began "painting" daily, always striving for the perfect combination of color and style. Suddenly, once JB had developed a portfolio, a door opened.
