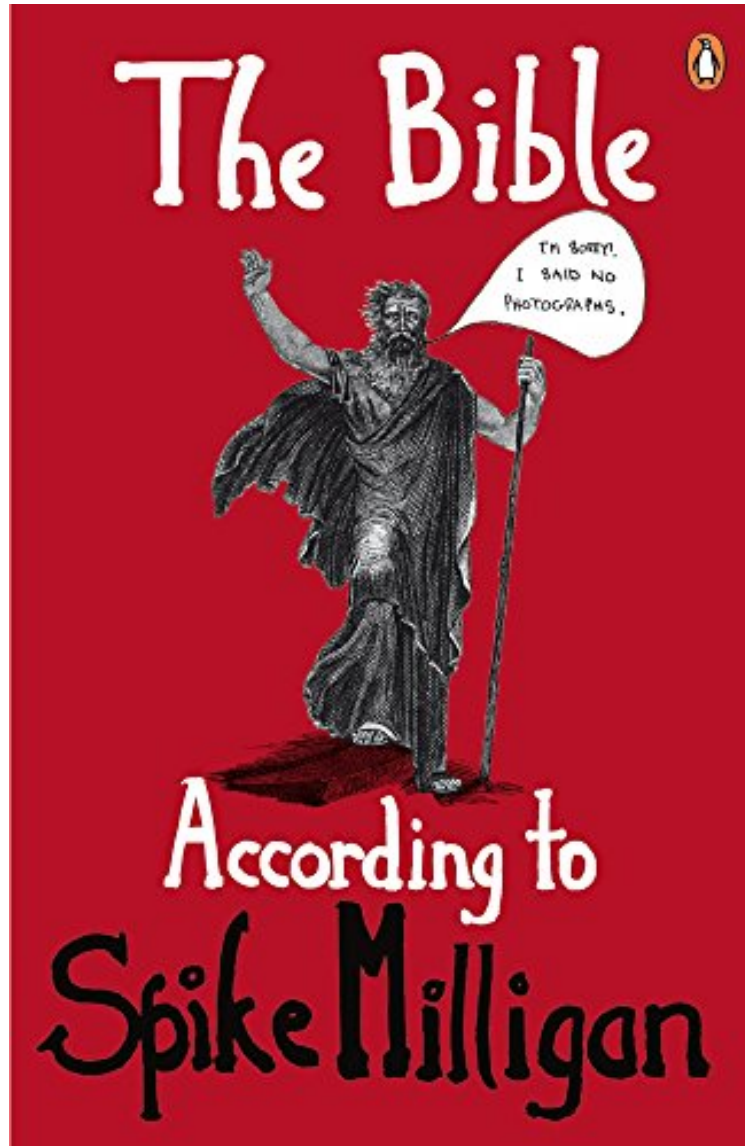

Spike's combined book sales total over 6 million copies, and he received an honorary CBE in 1992. He died in 2002.
